Performance Review

In the one month period ending 31 May 2024, the Fund's Z shares returned 0.97% (net of fees)¹, while the benchmark returned 1.56%.

Year-to-date (YTD), the Fund returned 9.51%, outperforming the benchmark return of 5.27%.

Market Review

Asia ex Japan equities advanced year-to-date. The energy, utilities, communication services, information technology and financials sectors outperformed the benchmark, while the health care, real estate, consumer staples and materials sectors declined and underperformed the benchmark.

Portfolio Review

Fund outperformance YTD was due to stock selection in the consumer discretionary, real estate and information technology sectors. Stock selection in financials and communication services and an overweight in consumer staples detracted from relative performance.

Outlook

As a team, we continue to focus on bottom-up stock selection and the long-term outlook for companies owned in the portfolio. We assess company prospects over a five- to ten-year time horizon and own a portfolio of what we believe are undervalued, high quality companies with diverse business drivers not tied to any particular market environment.
